



This letter is meant to certify the nature of the interaction between the Governance Accountability and Participation Program (GAPP) and the Centre for Economic Empowerment Uganda (CEE-UG).

CEE-UG is a local NGO initially founded in 2003 by three volunteers. It is based in the West Nile region of Uganda with its headquarters in Yumbe District.

The GAPP Program is a seven (7) year program funded jointly by USAID and DFID. The overall goal of GAPP program is to increase participation, accountability, and local governance for effective service delivery in Uganda in 35 designated districts.

In 2015, CEE-UG was selected by the GAPP Program for capacity building with a view to enhance the impact of CEE-UG's mission of strengthening civil society, voice, and accountability in Yumbe District. GAPP's technical support for institutional development began with the administration of a Partner Local Capacity Assessment (PLOCA) in 2015. Since then, CEE-UG has implemented the following action points identified during the PLOCA exercise: reviewing their human resource policies, developing standard operating procedures, and preparing and submitting three proposals to seek additional funds.

In 2016, GAPP continued to provide training to the CEE-UG in strategic resource mobilization, advocacy/lobbying, and the development of a strategic plan. GAPP will continue to provide ongoing technical assistance to further strengthen the organization through 2019.

The Organization works in all the 124 Primary Schools in Yumbe District. Their key thematic areas include: -

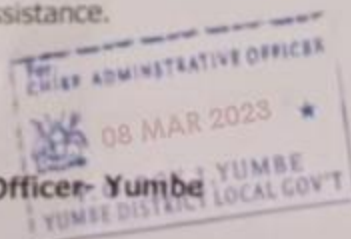
